Cadets will be responsible for following all policies and procedures and will be held personally accountable for their actions or inactions. The rules for cadet behavior are as follows: (Please initial where indicated)

1. You are expected to do your best at all times.

YOU are responsible for YOU! It's not your parent's responsibility to make sure you get up on time, wear your uniform on the appropriate day, or do your class work.

2. Wear your uniform properly and with pride.

When you disrespect the uniform by not wearing it properly and maintaining the required grooming standards, you disrespect the memories of the service men and women who made the ultimate sacrifice to defend our freedoms and way of life.

3. Be prepared for class each and every day.

Bring all the materials necessary to participate in class. It is not our responsibility to provide you with paper, writing implements, or any other supplies. You will be expected to complete all assignments on time and be prepared to participate in class discussions and activities.

4. You will be expected to be respectful to everyone at all times.

Directions given by administrators, teachers, staff, and class leaders will be followed without question. When addressing any adult on campus you will use their title (i.e. Mr., Mrs., Dr., etc) and their last name. When spoken to you will answer with "Yes/No Sir/Ma'am". Complaining, arguing, raising your voice, or refusing to comply will not be tolerated. When you have an issue with a direction you've been given, follow the chain of command to address your concern. This means:

- a) Comply with the direction
- b) Respectfully request to speak with your cadet flight commander to resolve the issue. If the cadet flight commander cannot resolve the issue, then,
- c) Respectfully request to speak with the cadet Inspector General in an attempt to resolve the issue. If the cadet Inspector General cannot resolve the issue, then,
- d) Respectfully request to speak to SMSgt Simmons who will resolve the issue. Only if SMSgt Simmons feels it is necessary, will the issue be elevated to Lt Col Cavallaro for resolution.

Respect other people's property and person. This means keep your hands to yourself, do not use inappropriate or degrading language and do not touch what does not belong to you without permission.

5. Classroom protocol is as follows and will be adhered to at all times.

- a) Be in class, in place when the bell rings.
- b) Stand at Parade Rest next to you seat until directed to take your seat.
- c) When seated, sit up straight facing forward with your feet on the floor
- d) Do not leave your seat until you ask and have been granted permission to do so.
- e) Chewing gum, eating or drinking in the classroom is prohibited
- f) IPODs, CD players, and all other electronic devices (except cell phones) are not allowed in the classroom. Cell phones may not be used during school hours.
- g) Hats, hoods, do-rags, and sunglasses will not be worn in class.
- h) Pants will be pulled up and shirts will be tucked in at all times (PT gear included).
- i) All school rules and guidelines will be followed and strictly enforced.

6. Military protocol will be complied with at all times.

- a) SMSgt Simmons will be addressed as; Sergeant Simmons, or Senior Master Sergeant Simmons.
- b) Lt Col Cavallaro will be addressed as, Sir; Colonel Cavallaro, or Lieutenant Colonel Cavallaro.
- c) When in uniform and outdoors you will render a salute to Lt Col Cavallaro and all cadet officers who are senior to you in rank.
- d) When The Colors (the U.S. Flag) pass by you will; when in uniform, stop, come to attention and render a salute and hold the salute until The Colors have passed. When not in uniform the salute is optional.
- e) When in the classroom and a guest enters, if required, the instructor will call the class to attention. If seated you will come to attention in your seat. This is done by, sitting up straight with your feet flat on the floor; your right hand flat on the desk palms facing down, and your left hand flat on your left thigh palm facing down. If standing, come to the position of attention in place. Stay at attention until directed otherwise.
